Lesson Title: How beautiful is the world!

Objective:

Discovering God's Beautiful World: To help children understand and appreciate the beauty of the world as a gift from God.

Introduction:

(Ice breaking)

Begin by asking the children what they think makes the world beautiful. Encourage them to share their thoughts and observations.

Teaching Points to be covered:

<u>God's Creation</u>: Explaining to the Childrens that how God created the world and everything in it. Explaining in brief about Adam and Eve's story. *(showing few images of the majestic aspects of earth)*

<u>Appreciating Nature</u>: Teaching children to appreciate the beauty of nature around them. Encouraging them to go on a nature walk with their families and observing the flowers, trees, birds, and insects around them.

<u>Caring for Creation</u>: Explaining the importance of taking care of the world that God has given us. Discussing simple ways how we can help, such as picking up litter, recycling, and conserving water.

<u>Gratitude</u>: Teaching children to be thankful for the beauty of the world and the blessings it brings. Encourage them to say a prayer of thanks to God for his wonderful creation.

Practical Application/Habit Formation

Thank God for beautiful creation we say everyday in your prayers.

Activities:

<u>Pictionary</u>: playing a game with Children to identify the drawing made. (eg. animals, waterfalls, mountains etc.)

<u>Nature Collage</u>: Provide children with magazines, coloured paper, and glue. Let them create a collage of things they find beautiful in nature.

<u>Outdoor Scavenger Hunt:</u> Create a list of items for children to find on a nature walk, such as a colourful leaf, a smooth rock, or flowers.

<u>Planting a Seed/sapling</u>: Give each child a small pot and some seeds. Let them plant the seeds and watch them grow, teaching them about the beauty of new life.

Sing the song: Teach the song given in the text with action

Bible Verse: write and learn Psalm 107:1

Conclusion:

Wrap up the lesson by reviewing what the children have learned about God's beautiful world. Encourage them to continue exploring and appreciating the beauty of nature around them.
