

# Lesson Plan

## FAITH EXPLORERS

### Chapter 10

## Jesus Anointed by the Holy Spirit

### Objective

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to:

1. Know that Jesus was baptized and received the Holy Spirit.
2. Understand that baptism makes us children of God.
3. Learn that the Holy Spirit helps us to live like Jesus.

### Introduction

( Choose any one )

#### *Starter 1 – Picture Guessing Game*

*Show 2–3 pictures (a dove, water, a candle, people praying).*

*Ask: “What do these remind you of?”*

*Let children guess. Then say: “These are all signs we see in Baptism. Today we will learn about Jesus’ baptism and how it makes us God’s children.”*

#### *Starter 2 – Action Song (5 min)*

*Begin with a short joyful action song on the Holy Spirit (clapping, hand movements).*

*After the song, say: “Just as we sang joyfully, the Holy Spirit fills us with joy when we are baptized.”*

## Presentation of the Topic

*Tell the story of Jesus’ Baptism in simple words.*

- *Jesus came to the Jordan River.*
- *John the Baptist baptized Him.*
- *The Holy Spirit came down like a dove.*
- *God’s voice said: “This is my beloved Son.”*

**Explain:**

- *At baptism, we too receive the Holy Spirit.*
- *We become God’s children.*
- *The Holy Spirit helps us to do good, like Jesus.*

## Habit Formation

**Teach children: “Since I am baptized, I will try to live like Jesus by...”**

- **Saying kind words.**
- **Sharing with others.**
- **Praying every day.**

## Activity

☐ **Role Play:**

Children act out the Baptism of Jesus (one as John, one as Jesus, others as people watching, one as the “voice of God”).

☐ After:

Ask, “What happened to Jesus at baptism?” → “He received the Holy Spirit.”

☐ Connect:

“The same happens to us at baptism.”

## Bible Verse

Read and Learn:

**“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me.” (Luke 4:18)**

## Conclusion

End with a short prayer:

“Come, Holy Spirit, help us to live like Jesus”
