STD 3 & 4

Man Who Loses Divine Life

1. Objective:

BY THE END OF THE LESSON, STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO:

Understand the meaning of Divine Life.

Recognize how sin separates us from God.

Learn about the story of Adam and Eve and the first sin.

Know the importance of God's love and forgiveness.

2. Introduction :

Begin with a short prayer.

Ask a few simple questions:

- Who gives us life?
- What makes us children of God?

Introduce the topic:

Sometimes people turn away from God and lose His special life in them. Let's learn how this happened first in the Bible.

3. Presentation:

Tell the story of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden (in a simple and child-friendly way).

Use pictures or illustrations if available.

Highlight:

- God's love and the beautiful life He gave.
- The rule God gave *them*.
- How they disobeyed God (the first sin).
- What happened after they sinned.

Key Teachings

- What is Divine Life? (God's life in our soul, given through grace)
- What is Sin? (Saying 'no' to God)
- What happens when we sin? (We move away from God's love)
- Does God stop loving us? (No! He always loves and forgives us.)

Activity:

- Coloring sheet – A picture of Adam and Eve or a heart showing Divine Life being restored.
- Fill in the blanks or matching words – Based on the story and key teachings.
- Role play – Act out the story briefly.

Bible verse:

Read and Learn

Genesis 3:9

Habit Formation:

1. I will not tell lie
2. I will obey my parents
3. I will pray daily.

Summarize the lesson:

- We should always try to stay close to God.
- When we make mistakes, we can say sorry to God (Confession).

End with a short prayer:

“Dear God, help me to love You and say yes to You always.”
