LESSON PLAN Chapter 5

Grade 5 & 6: Torch bearers Moses The Liberator

Learning Objectives

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to:

- Retell the life story of Moses and his mission to liberate Israel.
- Understand the meaning of divine call and obedience.
- Reflect on how God chooses the weak to accomplish His mission. Apply the values of trust, courage, and faithfulness in their daily lives

Lesson Procedure

I. Introduction (10 minutes)

- Begin the chapter with a question, "Have you ever felt unqualified to do something important?"
- Introduce the idea that God often calls those who feel unworthy—just like Moses.

II. Presentation of the Main Topic (30 minutes)

Narrate the story of Moses covering the below bullets-

- Oppression in Egypt
- Birth and adoption of Moses

- His escape to Midian
- The burning bush and God's call
- The mission and signs
- Partnership with Aaron
- First encounter with Pharaoh

Bible verse for reflection:

Exodus 3:7

Then the LORD said, "I have seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters; I know their sufferings."

- Let this verse remind us that God is not a mere observer during our times of difficulties; instead He too shares our distress

- He just wants us to return and call Him out where He will be ready waiting for us with a solution.

Bible verse: Read and Learn

Exodus 3:7

Activity

- 1) Questions for discussion:
 - Why do you think God chose Moses despite his weaknesses?
 - What does this story tell us about God's presence in our struggles?
 - Can you relate to Moses' fear of speaking or sense of inadequacy?

2) In small groups, students create a short roleplay of the "Burning Bush" scene or Moses before Pharaoh.

Habit Formation

- 1. As Moses obeyed God's call, I will obey my parents and those guiding me."
- 2. I will do the duties assigned to me with sincerity.

Closing Reflection and Prayer

As we conclude today's lesson, remember that life will have its challenges, but trust that there's a greater plan unfolding for each of us.
