

# Objective (Learning Outcomes)

Students will understand that Jesus has completed His task on earth to glorify God. And now He sits at the right hand of the Father. We who believe in Him await His second coming to judge us.

Also,

The students will become familiar with some of the liturgical seasons and feasts in the course of this lesson

#### Starter:

Start by asking the students if they have had or know of someone who has had a life changing experience with Jesus. Ask them what the term 'Glory to God' means to them. Encourage them to suggest ways in which their lives can contribute to Glorify God.

#### Presentation:

Describe how Jesus has been glorified, how He has been given a special in Heaven by the Father

- Summarize the main points of the lesson:
- □ Explain Jesus' second coming and its purpose.
- □ Emphasize that we will all be judged at the end and our actions while on earth will be the deciding factor.
- □ Discuss the various liturgical seasons related to the topic and the feasts celebrated related to the lesson's topic.

Read and discuss key Bible verses such as John 14:2-4 and Mathew 25:31 -46 to reinforce that Jesus is the way to the Father and that Judgement of all nations will surely take place.

## Practical Application:

Each morning, look at a cross or picture of the Risen Christ and say:

`₩ "Jesus, You are alive! Be with me in all I do today."

## Bible Verse:

Introduce Mathew 25:40 as the memory verse for the lesson:

"Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did to me."

Encourage students to memorize and reflect on this verse throughout the week.

## Activity:

Prepare a chart with matching exercises related to the lesson. Write down actions that are pleasing to the Lord as it is mentioned in the statements of the Last Judgement.

#### For example:

I was hungry, you gave me food.

I was thirsty, you gave me drink, and so on

### Closure:

Summarize the main points of the lesson:

- Jesus is the king of kings and is glorified in heaven.
- Jesus assures us that HE will come again to judge us and take us to Him.
- The seasons and feast associated with lesson

End with a prayer, asking for Jesus who is our resurrection and our Hope to bless us to be at His right side on His second coming.

# Homework (optional):

Encourage students to reflect on one way they can live a fruitful life in order to live with Him.
