

# Lesson Plan

## FAITH EXPLORERS

### CHAPTER 14

## People Led by the Spirit

### Objective

**The Holy Spirit empowers us to live and spread the Gospel with courage and love.**

Help students understand that though we can't see the Holy Spirit, He is real and powerful.

### Introduction

*Ask: "Have you ever seen the wind?" (Let kids respond.)*

*□ Follow up: "Can you feel it? What happens when the wind blows?"*

*□ Explain: "Just like the wind, we can't see the Holy Spirit, but He is with us, helping us, guiding us, and giving us power from God."*

### Presentation of the Topic

## The Spirit Makes Us Brave and Wise

- **Story Time:** Briefly narrate the story of Pentecost and how the Holy Spirit changed the apostles.

**"The apostles were scared at first. But when the Holy Spirit came, they were filled with courage. They went out and told everyone about Jesus!"**

## Highlight the 7 Gifts of the Holy Spirit:

- o Wisdom
- o Understanding
- o Counsel (right judgment)
- o Knowledge
- o Fortitude (courage)
- o Piety (love for God)
- o Fear of God (respect for God)

*Use simple visuals or flashcards with a symbol for each gift to help them remember.*

## Habit Formation

We can be led by the Spirit by listening to God's voice, reading the Bible, praying, being kind, and telling others about Jesus through our actions.

## Activity

### Holy Spirit Flame Craft

 Materials Needed:

- Red, orange, and yellow construction paper, Glue sticks
- Small cutouts with each of the 7 gifts
- A cutout dove or flame shape labeled "Holy Spirit"

 Instructions:

\*Kids paste the flame on their notebook or card paper.

\*Around the flame, they stick the 7 gift labels.

\*Ask them to write or draw one way they can use a gift this week (e.g., use courage to say sorry, use wisdom to choose what's right).

**Optional Sharing:** *Let a few kids share what gift they chose and how they'll live it out.*
