Holy Qurbana The Highest Form Of Worship

Objective

• Understand the theological and liturgical meaning of Holy Qurbana in the Syro-Malabar tradition.

- Explain why Holy Qurbana is the highest form of worship.
- Identify and explain the structure and key elements of the Syro-Malabar Qurbana.
- Reflect on their own participation in the Qurbana with reverence and devotion

Introduction

• Ask students the question:

What is the most powerful way we can connect with God as a community?

Encourage a short discussion.

Show a short 2-minute video clip or image of a solemn Holy Qurbana celebration (incense, altar, communion, etc.)

What do you feel when you watch this?

Why do you think this is important in our faith?

Presentation of the Topic

What is Holy Qurbana?

- It is the re-presentation of Christ's eternal sacrifice on Calvary.
- It is thanksgiving, praise, and communion.
- It unites heaven and earth.

Why is it the Highest Form of Worship?

- It was instituted by Jesus during the Last Supper.
- It includes body, soul and spirit in worship.
- We participate in the eternal sacrifice of Jesus.
- We receive the true Body and Blood of Christ.

Structure of the Syro-Malabar Qurbana

Introductory Rites (Raza Qurbana)

Preparation, penitence, and entrance hymn.

<u>Liturgy of the Word</u>

Readings, Homily, Karozutha (intercessions).

<u>Liturgy of the Eucharist</u>

Offertory, Anaphora (including Epiclesis and Institution Narrative), Fracture, Communion.

Luke 22:19-20, Corinthians 11:23-26 & Hebrews 9:11-14

Habit Formation
